



FAIR SHARE: PAY \$300 / WORK OFF \$200 VOLUNTEER INSTRUCTIONS:

If you and your family selected this Fair Share payment option when paying your band fees, here are the instructions for reducing your \$200 balance. Contact the Volunteer Coordinator if you have any questions at: Volunteer@napleshighband.com.

<u>Volunteer</u>	Work	Fair Share Reduction
Parents/Adults	10 hours	\$100
Band Student/Siblings*	10 hours	\$ 50 *Siblings must be 12 yrs or older.

At the end of the year, portions/fractions of hours will be rounded:

Adults: 1 hour = \$10

Students: 1 hour = \$5

RULES: (Please read carefully.)

1. Working in Concessions is the best way to reduce your Fair Share balance. All other jobs that are Fair Share eligible will be designated with an “**FS**” when you sign up on the Volunteer Portal. (Examples: Football Games, SWFL Music Games, Spring Lacrosse Games, Spring Track Meets, NHS Soccer Games, Trailer Pulling for parades, *Rhythm and Blues* Dinner.)

2. To receive credit for Fair Share volunteer hours, you must 1) sign up on the **Volunteer Portal** through the NHS Band website (NaplesHighBand.com) **AND** 2) you must sign in/out using the **Volunteer Logbook** located at Home-side Concessions. Both will be verified for proof of hours worked.

The *Volunteer Logbook* contains blue “Family Pages” organized by each band student’s last name for all adults/students/siblings to keep track of hours worked. If the event is not concessions-related, sign up on the Volunteer Portal as usual, and report to the specific event coordinator who will verify your hours.

3. Parents, Students/Siblings, and Alumni are welcome to volunteer and donate their Fair Share hours to students in need. The Volunteer Logbook will have special white pages in the back of the binder for anyone wishing to donate hours toward other students’ Fair Share fees. This also applies to those whose Fair Share balance is paid in full but would like to volunteer anyway.

4. Band students who wish to receive a Letter for Band must volunteer an *additional* 4 hours throughout the year once their Fair Share balance has been met. Mr. Laz has the final say on which underclassmen qualify for a Letter. Students must maintain good attendance, good grades, abide by the rules of the Handbook, and audition for All-State and/or All-County Band.

5. Remaining Fair Share balances-up to \$200-will be billed in March 2027 with a final payment due by April 1, 2027. No exceptions. Unpaid balances will be turned over to the NHS front office and will incur penalties such as not attending prom or even graduating.
